Roulette has been around since the 18th century, and over this time, there have been several big winners. One of the biggest recent wins in roulette was won by businessman Pedro Grendene Bartelle. He won an astounding R\$3.5 million in 2024 playing French roulette.

Biggest Roulette Winners?

For most gamblers, a win on roulette is generally small to mid-range in size. Big bets sometimes result in some of the biggest wins. Let's go through some of the biggest roulette winners!

Charles Wells: Let's start with Charles Wells, as he was one of the first big winners of roulette. While playing a European roulette game, he won 23 out of 30 spins.

In 1891, he won a fantastic 2 million Francs. He became known as "the man who broke the bank at Monte Carlo" as the casino ran out of money when he won.

Sean Connery: Sean Connery may not have the biggest roulette win, but we thought we would mention this acting legend anyway! In 1963, Connery won an astounding \$27,000 playing European roulette from betting on 17 three times in a row. That's pretty great, considering the odds of this happening are 1 in 50,653.

Mike Ashley: Billionaire entrepreneur Mike Ashley won £1.3 million playing European roulette at a casino in London in 2008. He won big from betting on 17.
